

Booster Club Meeting Minutes 1/13/16

Coaches Presentations:

Boys Track – missed their rollover last spring but presented for sprinter singlets and jackets. A portion of the jackets were already purchased so a reimbursement was requested.

Girls Track – uniform tops and shorts were presented for. The warm-ups they have are in good shape and they have a good inventory so they are not asking for warm-ups this year.

AD Report:

The Classic 8 will hold a sportsmanship summit this year. Representatives from the AAC will attend on behalf of North. They will also make a visit to Butler to promote high school sports and summer contact opportunities.

The spring schedule should be finalized soon. We've added an additional track meet this year. KM is redoing their track so we will host their varsity meet and take concessions.

Conference realignment was discussed. There will be upcoming meetings with the WIAA on 1/19/16 and 1/27/16. Brian and Matt Harris have both been interviewed recently by the Freeman and WTMJ on this subject.

Initial proposals were brought forward for three projects. The softball and baseball practice fields as well as new diving blocks for the pool. A spreadsheet of costs and a funding plan was discussed. Suggestions were made for more information regarding transportation to off-site practice fields and requesting money from the co-op school's booster clubs.

Treasurer:

We are about \$4,000 behind last year. This can be accounted for by the decision not to do football mania as well as the balance of basketball games in the schedule. Overall we are ahead in other areas.

It was suggested to look into insurance to cover the club in the event that any funds were stolen, in light of the recent PTO issues at Hawthorne.

Mr. Blackjack contracts are signed and the dates are set.

The new location in the hallway was beneficial and new stock is being looked into.

Scholarships:

Cindy requested that Brian re-send the information for Kyle Bedalov to put on the website. It was also discussed that there will need to be reminders sent out to families as the deadline for application approaches.

New Business:

It was discussed to restructure concessions to have 1 board member oversee it in general and several leads trained to spread out the work load.

Certificates for “super volunteers” based on concessions lists that are presented at the scholar athlete banquet was brought up.

Creating a program where board members who have served at least 2 years receive a free lifetime membership was discussed.

Greg Deets shared with the board that he will be running for school board and shared his business card and website information with the group.

Texas Hold'em:

Wendy and Brian are working on rounding up the coaches that have not contributed baskets.

About 21 people are registered, we need at least 50.

New baskets were donated from independent contractors.

50/50 Raffle:

There were issues with Boys Volleyball not being on time or following directions. Using parent volunteers for credit towards concessions slots was discussed. Also if a team does not meet expectations they may not be allowed to do it again for a period of time.

Voting:

Boys Track was approved for \$481 for uniforms and \$1,050 for warmups for a total of \$1,531.

Girls track was approved for \$1,293 for uniforms
