OUR CURRENT SITUATION

- One team set (25) of white Mizuno cut-off style jerseys and pants in good condition, used by the varsity team in 2010
- Limited one team set (13) of purple cut-off style jerseys and pants in good condition, used by the JV team in 2010
- Mixture of two other uniform sets that are in poor condition due to holes, tears, and original screen prints and tackle-twill displays falling off, not suitable for game play even at lower levels
- Our freshmen team used a team set (18) of purple two-button jerseys that were used as varsity “undershirts” prior to 2010, all of which are in fair to poor condition

OUR NEW LOOK

- Full-length button-down pro-style jersey, purple with white accents
- 1/8” braid piping down jersey midline and on sleeves
- 4” two-color tackle-twill numbers on the front left of the jersey (white with columbia blue accent)
- 8” two-color tackle-twill numbers on the back of the jersey (white with columbia blue accent)
- Vertical arch two-color tackle-twill “NORTH” on the front of the jersey (white with columbia blue accent)
- Custom Northstars baseball logo embroidered on upper back
- Pro-style open hemmed pants with 1/8” purple braid piping down the sides

- Light-weight uniforms with excellent moisture management and breathability to withstand the summer baseball season
- High-quality material with durability that will easily last 10+ years or 300+ games
- A professional look that will present a positive image for Waukesha North Baseball

OUR REQUEST

The Waukesha North baseball program is requesting that the Booster Club make a financial contribution of \$2,158, equivalent to 50% of our new uniform purchase with Gerry Davis Sports, Inc.

We believe this purchase will benefit the varsity baseball team and the program as a whole over the next decade and beyond. We strive to put a first-class product on the field every day, and strongly believe that our uniform quality is a part of that equation.

BOOSTER CLUB QUESTIONS

1. **Describe the need of booster club funding for your requested item.**

As we hope to purchase new varsity uniforms for the 2011 season, we are in need of booster club contributions. This is especially the case as we have the “good” problem of likely carrying a large roster of 20+ players again this year, and the total cost of uniforms has quickly grown.

2. **If you ask for more than one item and can only have one which one would it be?**

We are only requesting a contribution toward our uniform roll-over situation per the athletic department rotation. Due to our substantial request for our batting cage project earlier this spring, we understand that a full 50% contribution toward our uniform purchase may not be possible. However, we still look to take advantage of our program’s turn within the uniform roll-over cycle.

3. **Will the item requested be used for other sports? Which ones?**

This is a baseball specific purchase, with the intention of being passed onto our lower level teams once we reach the next uniform roll-over period.



4. Has your sports team done or plan to do any fund raising for the purchase of this/other items?

The baseball program raised over \$13,000 in 2010 through our program fund raiser, youth camps, and special events. For the 2011 calendar year, we have already seen \$5,000 come in through our camps, and we look forward to reaching our goal of \$15,000 raised.

5. When was the last time booster club funding was received for this item?

The booster club has not contributed toward any baseball uniform purchase besides the previous roll-over situation 3+ years ago.

6. Describe how the requested item will enhance the performance of your athletes.

Our new uniforms will benefit our baseball players in numerous ways. Transitioning to a lighter weight material with various mesh and flex inserts will provide our players will greater flexibility and breathability while wearing the uniform, which is ideal for the hot summer nights that we play. Further, we strongly believe in promoting a positive image for Waukesha North baseball. We believe that these new uniforms will attract positive attention to our players and program, building upon what we have already been able to establish.

7. Describe how the requested items will enhance the field of play?

The requested item does not enhance the field itself, but these new uniforms will be worn by Waukesha North baseball players for more than 300+ games over the next decade. This is especially important as our younger players can feel a sense of pride in a quality uniform, rather than the sub-par jerseys we currently have for them.

8. Where will this item be stored?

All uniforms are stored in the baseball/softball cage when not in use.

9. Is your sport a co-op with other schools?

Baseball is not a co-op with any other schools.
